The publicity highlighting the presentation of antique cars is a great contribution to the Stockbridge Chamber of Commerce and its Holiday event.

Antique car participants who register in advance will receive a car plaque and one free "Main Street Buttons" which offers admittance to Sunday's activities, upon arrival. **Please note that the street will be closed to traffic at 11:30am with activities held between 12noon & 2pm. Therefore, car owners are asked to arrive between 11:00-11:30am. Cars that best duplicate the Main Street picture should park on The Red Lion Inn side of the street with other models directly across the street.**

If you arrive while the road is blocked, please enter onto Main Street from the Red Lion Inn side. Upon arrival, park your car on the appropriate side of street and check-in with Doug Goudey who will be in the Wheeler & Taylor Office Building at 11:00am.
